The League of Women Voters believes that early intervention and preventive measures are effective in helping children reach their full potential. The League supports policies that promote the well-being of children and youth.

We want to lend our support to LB869, which assures that juvenile convictions will be sealed if the petition is dismissed, if the juvenile completes diversion, mediation, probation, supervision, or other treatment or rehabilitation programs, or if the juvenile has satisfactorily completed the diversion or sentence ordered by the court. This seems an important and appropriate revision of the law that permits juveniles to live without the frequent costs of such behavior on their futures. We believe LB869 is worthy of positive action by the Judiciary Committee to move it to General File and general debate in the Legislature.
